- POP STAR Awards will be made in two categories: Commercial and Residential
- Deserving commercial and residential properties are those which have recently completed noteworthy improvements in appearance including landscaping, painting and exterior remodeling and do not have open code violations.
- If there are no code violations, the Beautification Advisory Board will discuss and vote on the property at their next scheduled monthly meeting after receiving the nomination form.
- Each award recipient will be recognized at a regular Commission Meeting, receive a POP STAR AWARD Certificate, and be asked to place a POP STAR AWARD sign or plaque (provided & installed by City staff) on their property for one month.

POP STAR AWARD Criteria

1. Trees & Palms:

- Shade (canopy) trees are present and healthy, (3 large palms = 1 shade tree)___
- Trees & palms properly trimmed. No illegal pruning such as hat-racking, topping & over lifting___
- Trees and palms are proper distance from overhead powerlines and are not impeding right-of-way or obstructing vision___

2. Lawn:

- Grass thick healthy, recently mowed and edged___
- The swale area (adjacent to the street) is sodded and slightly depressed___
- Area free of trash___

3. Shrubs, blooming plants & groundcovers:

- Healthy, full, colorful, no indication of insects or disease___
- Beds are mulched with wood chips or deco rock___

4. Hedges:

- Neatly trimmed___
- Healthy, good color, no indication of insects or disease___
- Not impeding right –of-way or obstructing vision___

5. Vines:

- Well supported on fences, arbors, trellises ___

6. Pools and/or fountains:

- Free of trash and/or stagnant water, well maintained___

7. Commercial signage:

- Permitted sign, in good condition or new___

8. Exterior of building or house:

- Façade, walls, doors, windows in good condition or remodeled___
- Paint in good condition or recently painted, no peeling paint, mold or mildew___
- Roof in good condition, no mold or mildew or new___
- Porches, patios, walkways & fences in good condition ___

9. Commercial Parking lot:

- In good condition, free of trash, striped, wheel stops or curbed___
- If required: landscape islands have trees, palms, shrubs & sod & are healthy___
