Construction activities are expected to be **completed by April 3, 2017**.

Pavement restoration will occur once the installation is complete.

How will I be affected?

- There will be **detour signs** to re-route traffic.
- Businesses:** Customers will have access to your business at all times.
- Residential:** Residents will have access to their homes.
- Repairs will be addressed** quickly for all damaged driveways, landscapes, and irrigation.
- General:** There will be **NO** water service interruptions.
