

The GRAFFITI PATROL is a community beautification project combining the efforts of the Volunteer Corps, multiple city departments and local partners. This program is designed to address and eliminate the many forms of graffiti and nuisance stickers that can detract from the overall beauty of the City of Oakland Park *within 48 hours of reporting.*

Graffiti and stickers on our light poles, sidewalks, curbs, bus stops, walls, fences and buildings cause blight and are not representative of the fine city Oakland Park truly is. We have created a network of equipped volunteers ready to strike at any moment graphic assaults are reported.
