Only those with appointments may be tested. Must bring proper ID and confirmation number for appointment.

Testing Hours: 9am – 5pm Daily

Who can be tested: First responders and healthcare staff, including police, fire-rescue, medical staff and essential staff that is supporting the management agencies during the novel coronavirus pandemic. You must have COVID-19 symptoms and be prepared to show ID.

- People who are 65 or older with COVID-19 symptoms and have chronic conditions. You must show I.D.
- Individuals who are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms and have recently traveled internationally on a cruise or plane or have a compromised immune system. You must show I.D.

Pembroke Pines police say you can call 954-276-4680 in advance to pre-register for a screening. The registration hotline will open at 1 p.m. Monday.

Nurses wearing PPE will screen prospective patients. If a person meets the criteria, they will get a placard for their windshield to continue to the testing tents.

At the Testing Station:

Once the patient arrives to the testing area, a medic wearing a Tyvek suit will collect a sample with the swab of the nostril. Another service member will be responsible for scribing the information from the patient's placard to the bio-hazard bag, and another will be responsible for collecting the sample and placing it in the bag.

Results:

After the sample is in the bio-hazard bag, it will be refrigerated until it is shipped to a vendor for examination. Within three to four days, Memorial Healthcare System will notify patients of the results. The Florida Department of Health will follow up with instructions to patients with positive results.

Results expected to take 3 days
