## Getting Started with Mango Languages

1. Visit the library's website and click on the Mango Languages link. If it is no longer there, click on "Catalog, eBooks & Resources" on the left-hand side of the page and you'll find a Mango Languages link there as well.

**Mango Languages** provides fun audio-visual lessons to over 70 languages, including English as a Second Language (ESL) courses. Cultural and specialty themed lessons such as Wine and Cheese French, along with foreign language films are also available. Use your library card number to sign up and create your own personal login to track your progress during each lesson and to access Mango Languages online or through mobile apps anywhere at any time.



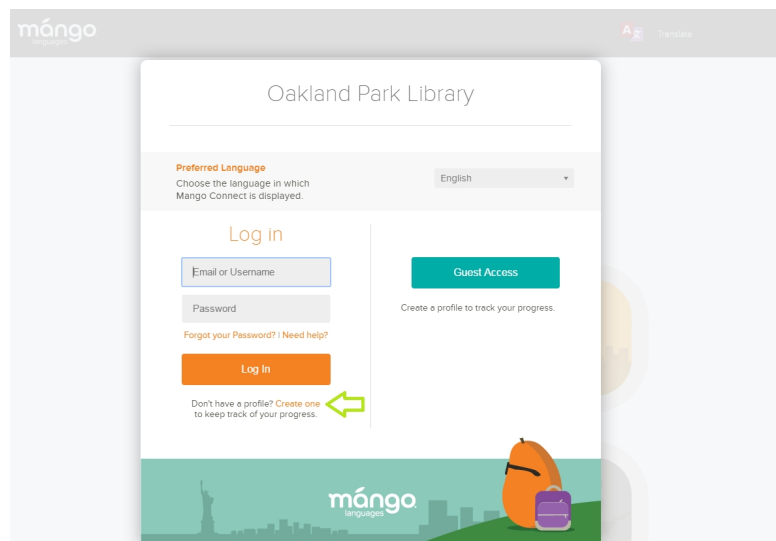
