



BULK TRASH COLLECTION SERVICE

Calendar Year 2026

The City of Oakland Park provides Bulk Trash collection service once per month.

Please refer to the bulk trash collection map to identify when bulk trash is collected in your area.

The following bulk trash collection rules and guidelines are provided:

- Bulk trash piles are limited to **10 cubic yards** of trash. This is equivalent to the size of a mid-sized car (like a Honda Civic), or approximately 3 feet high, 15 feet long and 6 feet wide.
- All bulk trash items are to be placed at the curb for collection no earlier than the Saturday prior to your scheduled collection week, which begins on Monday of each month.
- All bulk items, including items such as furniture, carpeting (up to 50 pounds), tree trimming, electronics, and appliances must be placed curbside in a neat and orderly manner no later than 7:00 a.m. on the Monday of the collection week for your area. *Collection may occur any day of your collection week, but no later than Friday.*
- All loose items, such as leaves, small twigs, grass clippings, etc. must be containerized or bagged, tied securely and must not exceed fifty (50) pounds each. If placed in containers for collection, the containers will be collected as bulk trash.
- Tree trimmings and branches shall not exceed eight (8) feet in length, or eight (8) inches in diameter.
- All glass (broken or intact) shall be wrapped in newspaper and placed in secure weatherproof containers for collection.
- White goods (appliances), large metal items, and electronics will be collected at the same time bulk trash is collected. Doors must be removed from appliances and valves must be removed from propane tanks.
- The City WILL NOT collect bio-hazardous waste or household hazardous waste (paints, gas, oil, insecticides, pesticides and other chemicals).

- The City WILL NOT collect construction or demolition debris (concrete material or lumber, including fence panels and pallets), tree stumps, auto or marine parts, sand, dirt, rocks, sod or bags exceeding fifty (50) pounds, without an additional charge.
- Bulk trash shall be placed at least four (4) feet from City provided refuse carts, fences, poles, fire hydrants, and parked cars.
- Bulk trash is not to be placed under low hanging trees or overhead wires.
- Bulk trash must be generated by the customer at the residence where the trash is collected and shall not be collected, without an additional charge, if the bulk trash is generated by someone other than the resident.
- Bulk trash left in front of vacant land or vacant homes will not be collected and will be subject to Community Enhancement Division action and additional charges.
- Condominium owners must place their collective bulk trash in one location located on common property. The collection location will be determined by the City and condominium association.
- Trash generated by contracted services will not be serviced.

Sec. 13-17. - Disposal of rubbish of tree surgeons, fence companies, similar work.

It shall be the responsibility of all fence companies, tree surgeons, nurseries and landscaping contractors, or any individual or company doing work on private property, to remove from the premises all rubbish resulting from such work.

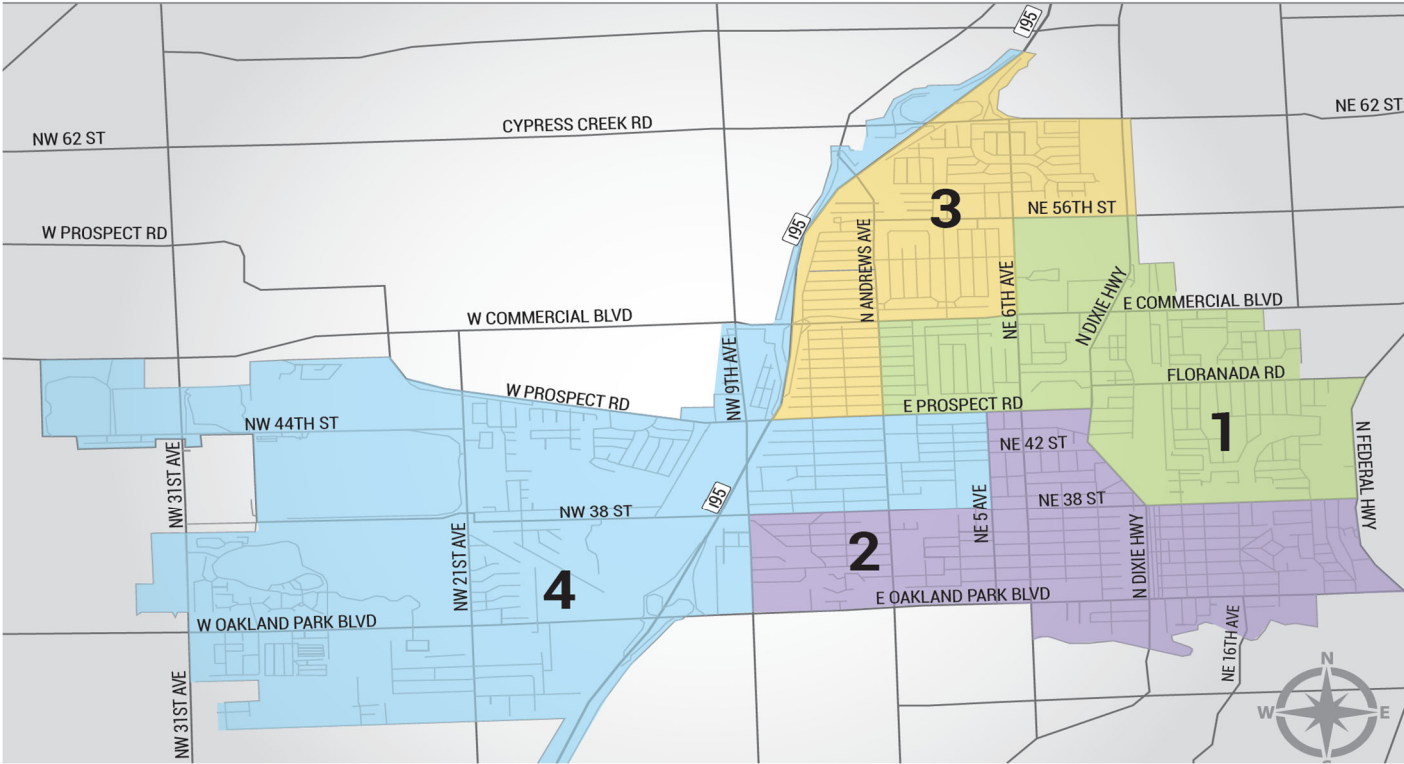
IMPORTANT NOTE: There is no bulk trash collection any week that is a 5th Monday of Month.

For 2026 there is no Bulk Trash collection service during the weeks of:

- March 30, 2026
- June 29, 2026
- August 31, 2026
- November 30, 2026

There is no solid waste service on Christmas Day.
