



Dear Commercial Recycling Customer:

The City of Oakland Park's Solid Waste Division has implemented an automated collection system for the collection of commercial and multi-family residential recycling carts. The new collection program will begin on December 31, 2012. For safety reasons, the automated collection of recycling carts requires the driver to remain in the cab when the carts are collected. The collection truck is outfitted with an arm that extends out, grabs the cart, empties the cart and sets the cart back in the place it was stored, all within a few seconds.

Beginning Monday, December 31, 2012, all commercial and residential recycling carts must be properly placed at the curb for collection. Staff will no longer move recycling carts from next to buildings or from enclosures in order to collect recycling carts. Please keep the recycling carts at least 3 feet from fences, light poles, fire hydrants, automobiles, and other carts.
